OPEN CLASS JUDGING by Roy Sinor (NCRS #2608)

Open Class Judging Team Leader



Please read this "Press Release" for our NCRS Membership regarding the new Open Class. I would appreciate it if you could relay this information to your Chapter members.

Roy has done quite a bit of work to get this judging class to the point where we can Move forward with judging. I do have Judging sheets available through, me at a need basis. Sorry, I have not had bulk sets made due to the fact that we are still tweaking the sheets during judging. Once the sheets are finalized, I will let chapters know bulk sets are ready for dispersment.

NCRS Open Class Judging

What if your Corvette is less than fifteen years old and does not qualify for flight Judging process? NCRS does not judge Corvettes in Flight Judging before they are fifteen years of age! NCRS now has a judging process to allow you to participate and learn about your cars if you wish. What if your car has been modified, and does not meet the Flight Judging Standard? NCRS now offers a Judging platform that will recognize those cars with owner inspired modifications. Even "re-engineered Corvettes" with or without body modifications may be entered into the Open Class judging where items are judged on their condition, not whether Chevrolet installed them during that model year. The Open Class evaluates your cars in addition to providing recognition for excellence in the areas of restoration, modifications, performance, or preservation. See a list of all of the [NCRS awards](#) and the criteria for you to earn them.

NCRS Open Class Award Judging

The National Corvette Restorers Society (NCRS) has begun a new program of Open Class Judging. The NCRS, famous for its meticulous Flight Judging process, has expanded its judging offerings to include a new category of Corvettes. This new category is called Open Class Judging and is offered for both Stock appearing and Custom Corvettes. It is open to Corvettes, built from 1953 to 2026. The car must have been born as a Corvette, have an original VIN Tag (or state issued replacement), and have a title/vehicle registration that states the car is a Corvette (i.e. no kit cars).

What is involved in Open Class judging and how does it work? Open Class judging also uses 5 teams of judges who evaluate the car in Operations, Interior, Exterior, Chassis and Mechanical. Unlike Flight judging, however, the teams are not concerned with originality. They are concerned with the function of the systems—in the case of Operations—and the Fit/Finish and completeness in all the other categories along with Cleanliness (do not fret, this is not a white glove or Q-tip review of cleanliness)

What constitutes a Stock or Custom Corvette for Open Class judging purposes? A Stock Corvette is one with the doors, hood and trunk closed, (excluding wheels & tires if no body or chassis modifications were required for fitment), including paint color (provided it appears to be a stock color or scheme), if the car basically appears like a production Corvette. From outward appearance of the car body appears to be stock or as it came from the factory. It can have show quality chrome and paint, a different motor than was originally in the car (but no computer controls). The key in this class is whether the car looks like it might be stock. Custom Corvettes include all other Corvettes. These can have flared fenders, custom paint such as flames pin stripes or other custom touches. This Custom Class opens the field for a wide variety of Corvettes that were not previously considered candidates for Flight judging. Open Class judging is an exciting new concept within the NCRS and is an exciting new way to open the field for a new generation of Corvette fanatics.

NCRS - Open Class Award®

First offered in 2025 Open Class Judging is offered for both Stock appearing and Custom Corvettes. It is open to Corvettes, built from 1953 to 2026. The car must have been born as a Corvette, have an original VIN Tag (or state issued replacement), and have a title/vehicle registration that states the car is a Corvette (i.e. no kit cars). Cars are judged on configuration, completeness, installation and finish with no regard for originality. The Awards presented will be Glass Plaques. Each Plaque will designate Chapter, Regional and National Levels.

Open Class cars successfully achieving a score of 94.0 points or above achieve an Emerald Award. Those achieving between 85.0 and 93.9 achieve the Ruby Award.

Future Expansion

In the near future we will expand the Open Class to include a separate division for C1-C3 RetroRod (re-engineered) cars. This division will require a chassis change along with computer controlled drivetrains. It is our intention to also further this Open Class program to include a Performance Verification and an Ultimate award for the class of a Zora Mark of Excellence Award.

1956-57 Fasteners for Windshield Retainer T-bolts

One of the items that is obscure on the 1956-57 Corvette is the fastener that attaches to the windshield T-bolt. There are eight of these that can be seen under the dashboard. These are listed in the 1956-57 JM on page 32 (Under Instrument Panel). "Fastener check; windshield is secured with one-piece flange/nuts (nickel size flange) with dum dum underneath,..." The 58-60 and 61-62 JM does not contain information for the windshield T-bolts fasteners.

I have looked in the Assembly Manuals that I have access to. The 1957 AIM (Section B, Sheet 5) shows plain washer, split washer, nut. These are the same fasteners listed in the 1959 and 60 AIM. For 1961, the windshield T-bolts are attached with 9417553 nuts. I cannot find a reference for that PN. The T-bolts are threaded for 12-24 nuts. These flange/nuts are also listed as free spinning washer nuts or spinner nuts in fastener catalogues. They have a conical attached washer.

After removing these fasteners on my car, I observed this. Under the dash in the area where the windshield T-bolts poke through, there is light fiberglass shade that is about a nickel sized diameter, then slightly darker fiberglass shade. I have also observed this shading on a December 56 Duntov car and a 58 fuel car. This is a giveaway of what was there for many years. Both cars have had their windshields replaced and have new hardware that is plain washer, split washer, nut.

When I obtained my car, the windshield had been replaced. It had the T-bolts attached by free spinning washer nuts. I replaced the windshield and lost those nuts. Here is how to obtain them.

I found the washer nuts as part of the 55-57 Chevy Paint Divider Moulding Clip. These are from Classic Industries (Classic Industries PN 748629). The 1955-57 Paint Divider Molding Clip Set; 6-piece set comes with 12-24 free spinning washer nuts. Their website says they replace GM nuts 4646559 and 4644959. If you order either of these GM nuts by PN, ensure they are 12-24, as 10-24 is a more common size. When installing these fasteners, tighten them to 30 in-lb.

Wanting to get additional information for other C1 cars, I contacted the team leaders. The 1953-55 team leader said the same washer nut was used on 1953-55 windshield T-bolts. The free spinning flange appears less cone shaped and flatter than the one pictured.

The 1958-60 team leader said he has seen original cars with both washer nuts, and with flat washer, lock washer, nut. They are 12-24 as the same T-bolt was used throughout solid axle production. They were also cad plated, not dichromate as shown. The 1961-62 team leader said 61-62 is the same as 58-60.
